## Beaver Lake Elite Series

- RULES: Interpretation and enforcement of these rules will be left exclusively to the Board of Directors. Decisions made by them shall be final in all matters.
   Protests must be made to a board member prior to the closing of weigh-in scales.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND PARTICIPATION: Participation is to be by application only. REQUIREMENTS:
- Participants must be at least 16 years of age.
- Application for membership must be accepted and paid. Membership fee will be \$40.00/person.
- Competitor's boat must be at least 14 feet in length and at least 25 horsep engine. Boat must have a working livewell and functioning acrator system.
- Competitor must abide by all Arkansas Insurance Regulations.
- Competitor must abide by all Arkansas Boating Laws and Regulations.
- Competitor must abide by all Arkansas Game and Fish Commission Laws and Regulations

  3. ENTRY FEE AND DEADLINE: The entry fice for BEAVER LAKE ELITE
  SERIES regular 5 tournaments will be \$100.00. Big Bass is included. The
  entry fice into the two-day BLES Championship will be \$100.00. Completed
  and tigned entry forms and entry fices will be joicted up and accepted up to 5:00
  PM. on the Wednesday prior to the tournament regular season scheduled event.
  Classic entries will be DUE Wednesday Oct 9th (week and half prior to the
  event.) Entries may be paid in advance; however, forms mus be completely filled
  out for each tournament at the time the fees are gaid. Fees must be paid by check
  or cash. Checks should be made payable to: "Beaver Lake Blite Series". There
  will be a \$30.00 service charge on any retrurned check. Entry fees are NON.
  REFUNDABLE. Entries may be turned in art. Hook, Line and Sinker (Rogen),
  Southrown Sporting Goods and Extreme Sports Boats.
- 4. ANGLER OF THE YEAR AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS: First place-200 points, second place-199 points, etc. Every competitor will receive 10 points for paying their entry. AOY will be awarded to the angler with the highest
- 5. TOURNAMENTS AND CHAMPIONSHIP: There will be 5 one-day regular season tournaments and a two-day championship. The top 25 in points, including ties, who have fished five regular season tournaments will compete in the BLES Championship. Take-off position in the Championship will be determined by finishing position in the Angler of the Year points on Day 1. Day 2 will be how you finish after Day 1. ""Anglers who pay to fish EVERY regular event will be qualified for the classic. No back pay allowed.

  6. PERMITTED FISHING LOCATIONS: Anglers are permitted to fish anywhere on Beaver Lake except: Within 50 feet of any commercial marina structure. Within the no-wake buoys at Prairie Creek including Prairie Creek predition to past the swimning area. Within any area manked. "No FISHING" by the Army Cops of Engineers. This also includes, but is not limited to, swimming areas and the buoyed off area around Beaver Dam. Within 50 feet of another competion's boat which was first anchored and secured in a fixed position (with trelling motor stowed).
- 7. TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT: Only artificial lures may be used-pork and pod-type baits are allowed. Only one rod may be used a one time. Before another rod may be used, all other rods must be reeled in and inside the boat. Multiple luter itps, such as unabella rigs, 'double drop-shot' or 'double fluke' type rigs are NOT ALLOWED. Only one lute may be used at a time. Landing nets are allowed in BLES tournaments.
- 8. METHODS OF FISHING: All standard methods of fishing are allowed
- Trolling. Either with the outboard or the trolling moto
- Snagging. Any visible fish, bedding or otherwise, must be caught inside the
- SAFETY: Contestants must wear a Coast Guard approved life preserver AND have a propedy working "kill switch" attached any time the combustion engine is operated above idle speed (on plane). Running lights must be operational and

- be used during low light conditions (ex. take-off, fog). All "No Wake" zones are to be observed and obeyed. Safe distances must be maintained during high speed
- 10. SPORTSMANSHIP: Courtesy and sportsmanship are to be shown by all contestants at all times. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are allowed during tournament hours and weigh-in.
- 11. SCORING/POSSESSION: Largemouth, Smallmouth, Meanmouth and Sported Bass will be counted. There will be a FIVE fish limit. There is a FIVE fish possession limit, meaning angler MUST CULL limediately after catching their sixth keeper. NO FISHING IS ALLOWED UNTIL THE CULL HAS BEEN sixth keeper. NO FISHING IS ALLOWED UNTIL THE CULL HAS BEEN MADE. A contrestant found to be fishing with now than five fish in the livewell will be disqualified! Largemouth, Smallmouth, and Meanmouth must measure 15°. Sported Bass must measure 12°. Anything other than a pure Spotted Bass will be considered a Meanmouth. (If it's brown, it must be 15°). Bass will be measured on a flat board with mouth closed, tailed pinched and in a "franning" manner. There will be a countery board available to cheef thin a twelpt.in. "Weigh-in will open 1 (one) hour prior to official weigh-in time. Ex: Scales will open at 3pm on the March event, etc. and will close 30 minutes after hat check-in time. In the event an issue with scoring or any other rule should arise, the angler will be asked to wait until a board member is present.
- PENALTIES: These penalties will be applied to final weigh-in totals and will be enforced by the Board of Directors.
- Short fish: Short fish will not be counted or weighed and a one-pound penalty will be assessed to the final weight.
- Dead fish: There will be a 4 ounce penalty for each dead fish presented to
- Too many fish presented for weigh-in: DISOUALIFICATION
- Late to check-in: DISQUALIFICATION. Anglers must be inside the busys at Prairie Creek to be considered "on time". If your due in time is 4:00:00pm 4:00:01 is late. Please notify an official if you leave early!
- 13. TIES: The will be resolved by adding points and money together and splitting between the tied competitors. Trophies will be given based on a coin toss by the Tournament Director or Board member. Big Bass ties will split the money. Ties in Angles of the Vear points will be broken by heaviest cumulative weight for the entire season. Classic ties will be determined by the largest stringer of the 2 days.
- 14. COMMUNICATION DEVICES: The use of mobile commu devices such as cellular phones, walkie-talkies, etc. to communicate fishing information of any kind during tournament hours is prohibited.
- 15. SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES:
- The Board has the right to delay take-off in the case of fog or inclement
- weather. Competitions are only allowed to leave the boat under dire circumstances or restroom breaks. Competitions are NOT ALLOWED to leave the boat to make a cast, land a fish, or access fishing water in any way.

  Anglers may make arrangements to get another boat in case of mechanical failure. He may also ride with another competition. However, the stranded fisherman may not fish and he may not assist the helping competitor.
- 16. QUALITY ASSURANCE TEST: By his or her signature on the membership form, contestants agree to submit to quality assurance tests (polygraph) in any or all BLES couraments. Refusal to submit by contestants will result in immediate dispusalification and subsequent disqualification from any future BLES events. No monies and/or awards will be given if you fail to pass or refuse to submit to quality
- 17. PAYBACK: Payback will be based on total number of paid entry fees.
